## ENTRY GUIDELINES



### INTRODUCTION

The Roy Sheargold Scholarship was founded in memory of one of the most respected figures in the property development sector, life member of UDIA National and NSW, Roy Sheargold. Roy sat on the Council of the Urban Development Institute of Australia (NSW) almost 50 years ago. He remained actively involved in the industry, UDIA and international industry bodies for more than 45 years. Roy believed that if you wanted to be a great developer you had to continually update your knowledge and travel the world to learn from international developers.

### AWARD OVERVIEW

The UDIA NSW Roy Sheargold Scholarship will be awarded annually to an individual who demonstrates exceptional professional and/or academic achievement. They would have leadership qualities, an ability to inspire others and aspirations to achieve and perform at the highest level. Ultimately this award is about helping individuals get to the next level. For this reason the ideal applicant would use the scholarship to conduct research, further their education and/or professional networks.

### SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT BENEFITS

The successful applicant for the 2019 Roy Sheargold Scholarship will receive financial assistance of up to \$7,500. The RSS Committee reserve the right to review the amount of financial assistance offered if deemed necessary. The successful applicant will be required to complete an acquittal report once the scholarship activity has been undertaken.

**Nominations open:** Wednesday 5 December 2018

**Nominations close:** Friday 1 February 2019

**Entry form due:** Friday 15 February 2019

**Winner Announced:** UDIA NSW event in March 2019

### HOW TO ENTER

Applicants can be self-nominated or nominated by a third party by Friday 1 February 2019. To enter, complete the two minute online nomination form which asks for the details of the nominee. The nominee will then be emailed an official entry form which they will need to complete and return via email to the UDIA NSW office with their CV and headshot by Friday 15 February 2019.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to enter, applicants must:

- » Be a member of the UDIA NSW
- » Currently be working in the property development industry or studying property or related fields;
- » Have an Australian Passport;
- » Be based in New South Wales and be available for an interview in February 2019

### JUDGING PROCESS

The RSS Committee will assess all applications and determine the 2019 Roy Sheargold Scholarship recipient. The winner will be announced at a UDIA NSW event in March 2019.
