Re: Draft Tree Management Policy

The Urban Development Institute of Australia (UDIA) NSW is the leading industry body representing the key participants in the development sector in NSW, with over 500 member companies including developers, planners, engineers, state agencies and local government. UDIA is grateful for the ongoing collaborative working relationship between industry and Council.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Council's draft Tree Management Policy (the Policy). UDIA supports the intent and objectives of the Policy, and both State and Local governments' vision for a greener Western Sydney. However, we have concerns with some aspects of the Policy and make the following recommendations:

Recommendation 1: Review the design guidelines, particularly on street tree location in verges.

We expect that tree siting requirements in Part 4.5 cannot be practically implemented and will conflict with other requirements. We recommend that tree planting be guided by the specific opportunities and constraints of each verge location rather than insisting on a uniform standard across the Shire.

Recommendation 2: Remove the prohibition in Part 4.6 on removing trees where they may cause damage to property (both Council and private property) and solar panels among other matters.

UDIA believes there should be reasonable allowance for the removal of trees that are causing damage to private or public property.

Recommendation 3: Ensure consistency with the Exempt an Complying Provisions of the Codes SEPP 2008 and Wollondilly LEP.

We note that the application of this policy to any tree above 3 metres in height is inconsistent with both the Codes SEPP 2008 and Wollondilly LEP that adopt an 8 metre height limit. The Policy should be amended to adopt the 8 metre height limit.
